Reykjavik is the capital of Iceland. Experience Reykjavik's culture represented through their art, architecture, and people through a quaint town of candy-coloured homes.

Reykjavik Guided Tour

Hallgrímskirkja Church (Entrance Included) - Admire the picturesque view of Reykjavik on the top of the church, which known for its distinctively curved spire and side wings. This church stands tall at 73m, making it the tallest structure in Iceland.

Harpa Concert Hall - Visit the magnificent gleaming structure on the water's edge with thousands of lights, and enchanting colours at night.

Sun Voyager - A sculpture located next to the Sæbraut road, it's described as a dreamboat. It conveys the promise of undiscovered territory and the dream of hope, progress, and freedom.

Laugavegur (Main Street) - Roughly translated to "The Water Road", originally known as an area to do laundry in its hot pools. Personal time to stroll along the **Rainbow Street** and stop by at shops, boutiques, restaurants, or bars.

Enjoy the delicious, rich, and creamy signature Icelandic fresh fish stew and fish soup in a cozy local restaurant.

Snæfellsnes Peninsula Encounter

Known as "Iceland in Miniature", this site has everything from mountains, caves, gorges, craters, waterfalls, beaches, and ocean views condensed together.

📍 **Mount Kirkjufell** - Known as 'Arrowhead Mountain' in the Game of Thrones universe. It is often called 'the most photographed mountain in Iceland' due to its dramatic formation and perfect coastal location.

Arnarstapi - Admire this cliff viewpoint's famous formation of stone arch and **Gatklettur** with numerous basalt columns.

Icelandic Horse Farm - Get up close and meet the unique breed of Icelandic horses known for their friendliness and vibrant personality. Proceed overnight in **Borgarnes**.

Godafoss Waterfall - Nicknamed the Waterfall of the Gods', this waterfall that spans 30m in width is nothing but mystical.

Lake Myvatn - Created in the basaltic lava eruption over 2000 years ago, the shallow lake's surroundings are dominated by volcanic landforms.

Dimmuborgir Lava Formations - Walk through the unusually-shaped lava fields, home to volcanic caves and rock formations.

Namafjall & Namaskard Hot Springs - Interspersed with fumaroles and mud pots, the colourful sulfur crystals and craters make for an other-worldly appearance.

DAY 7 **Breiddalsvik - Hofn - Vatnajokull National Park - Vik**

Breakfast Lunch

Hofn, the southeastern fishing village overlooking a tranquil bay is the langoustine capital of Iceland. Have a scrumptious lunch of fresh langoustine cooked in soup or grilled before continuing the journey, a must-have try in Iceland that shouldn't miss.

Vatnajokull National Park [UNESCO]

Transfer to one of the three national parks in Iceland, it encompasses all of Vatnajökull glacier and extensive surrounding areas.

Jokulsarlon Glacier Lagoon Boat Tour (Included) and Diamond Beach - Sail among the huge icebergs in the picturesque scenery of Jokulsarlon while admiring the floating icebergs causing a constantly changing landscape. At Diamond Beach, you will be left speechless as it is filled with icebergs looking like diamonds shimmering reflecting rainbow glints. **Available from May - October only.*

Proceed overnight in **Vik**.

South Coast Adventure

Myrdalsjokull Glacier and Katla Ice Cave Tour (Entrance and Super Jeep Included) - Enter the Ice Cave following a magical 'gateway' as blue and black ice walls stand like sentinels. The ice-dome looks like something from a Hollywood scene.

Reynisfjara Black Sand Beach - Created by lava flowing into the ocean which cools almost immediately when touching the water, formed the black sand beach that is there today.

Reynisfjall - Incredibly tall basalt columns towering cliffs and caves make for quite a sight.

Skogafoss Waterfall - Truly an impressive sight as you watch the water gracefully topples over the edge of the 60m cliffs and plummets into the Seljalands river.

Proceed overnight in **Selfoss**.

DAY 9 **Selfoss - Golden Circle - Reykjavik**

Golden Circle Experience

Strokkur Geysir Geothermal - Admire nature's sheer power. Each eruption shoots boiling water up to 40m into the air.

Gullfoss Waterfall - From above, it appears that this iconic Icelandic waterfall is swallowed back into the Earth! And with two separate cascades, it won't be an experience you'll quickly forget.

Thingvellir National Park [UNESCO] - Take a stroll at the national park and admire its truly outlandish landscape, shaped by the faults and cracks caused by continental drift.

Blue Lagoon (Comfort Pack Entrance Included) - Home to one of the 25 Wonders of the World, soak in and experience the tranquility of its unique, geothermal seawater for healthy and youthful skin. Pamper your skin with a volcanic mud mask while sipping on a glass of alcoholic drink for a relaxing time.
