(E) Cliffs of Moher (Entrance Included) - Standing at the entirely vertical edge, the Cliffs of Moher offer a dramatic panorama with the Aran Islands gracing Galway Bay below. The abrupt cliff edge provides a thrilling sense of height, and on clear days, the views are awe-inspiring.

Proceed overnight at **Dublin**.

Dublin Castle - A historic fortress since the thirteenth century, witnessing **City Hall -** A magnificent example of Georgian architecture. Well worth a stop to view its beautiful dome, richly coloured murals, ornate marble floors, and statues. Christ Church Cathedral - Amazed by the architectural marvel that weaves together centuries of history and religious significance in the heart of Dublin. College Green & Irish Houses of Parliament- Immerse yourself in the architectural elegance of this iconic area, surrounded by the legacy of Irish governance. Continue to visit O'Connell Bridge, Ha'penny Bridge and Temple Bar.
