Kuala Lumpur 🗡 Frankfurt - Wurzburg

Frankfurt, the heart of Europe known for exceptional art and history museums, impressive skyscrapers, as well as quaint, fun-loving neighbourhoods.

Frankfurt Guided Tour

Romerberg (Old Town) - Enjoy a stroll and snap some memories at the Fountain of Justice built in the 15th - 18th century as you spend your personal time along the old city

Old Opera House - The original building was destroyed in the war and later rebuilt as one of the most beautiful opera houses in the city.

Eiserner Steg Bridge - Walk on the iconic iron bridge and take a photo of the beautiful views of the skyline to the north toward the Museumsufer or south toward the Museum Embankment. Euro Sculpture - A symbol of the Eurozone, stands prominently in the city's financial district.

Experience the charm of a traditional German meal featuring Pork Knuckle and Apple Strudel. Wander through Romer Square before heading to Wurzburg for an overnight stay.

Wurzburg in Bavaria, Germany, is famed for its opulent baroque and rococo architecture. **Wurzburg Guided Tour**

Old Main Bridge - Marvel at the Alter Krahnen, an original old crane which helps unload ships as you stroll on the impressive stone structure lined with numerous Baroque statues of saints.

(I) Wurzburg Residence [UNESCO] - One of Europe's greatest Baroque palaces, stroll through the residence's beautiful garden on the palace grounds.

Walk through Marketplace, Falkenhaus Fountain, Maria Chapel, Marienberg Fortress, Wurzburg Cathedral.

Rothenburg ob der Tauber is well known for its well-preserved medieval old town in southern Germany and one of only three old towns in Germany with completely intact city walls.

Rothenburg ob der Tauber Guided Tour

Old Town - A popular place for the weekly market, local festivals, and occasional fireworks show. The popular shopping street here is filled with cafes and shops which goes up to Plönlein.

(Plonlein - Defined as a little square at the fountain, wandering through a picturesque spot in an enchantingly pretty town just as one right out of a fairytale.

Explore the City Wall, St. Jacob's Church, Rathaus, Blade Gate and Castle Gardens

Enjoy some personal time in **Rothenburg** before transferring overnight to **Fussen**.

(E) Neuschwanstein Castle (Entrance Included) Once intended for Bavaria's monarch, this architectural gem inspired Disney's Sleeping Beauty castle. Perched on a rocky ledge, it offers a fairytale ambiance with breathtaking mountain views. A must-visit, inviting you to step into its enchanting world!

Photo stop at Marienbrucke for a postcard view of the castle and the valley.

Transfer to **Zurich**.

(E) Zurich Christmas Market - Wander through twinkling lights and festive stalls, discovering timeless Christmas magic in a charming city. *Subject to opening dates

Old Town of Zurich - Located at the heart of Zurich, get lost in the winding road of this historic centre, find shops, cafes and soak up the long-passed atmosphere.

Grossmunster Church - One of the iconic landmark cathedral in Zurich with two matching towers, an impressive stained glass window and a bronze door.

Bahnhofstrasse - Spend your personal time exploring and shopping at Zurich's Shopping Boulevard, one of the world's most exclusive shopping avenues.

Lindt Chocolate (Entrance Included) - Explore an indulgent exploration of chocolate's allure, where the sweet scent of cocoa intertwines with the rich history of Lindt, o ering an immersive and delectable experience.

Proceed overnight stay at Colmar.



Visit the picturesque town of Colmar and experience the town's fascinating cultural heritage illustrated through its lovely residential houses.

Alsace Wine and Dine Experience (Included) - Discover the taste of Alsace through crafted delicacies and exceptional wines from the region.

Transfer to Interlaken, a town nestled between the Thun and Brienz lakes which is the shopping paradise for Swiss chocolate, precious jewellery and Swiss watches. Enjoy your personal time before dinner.

Hoheweg Boulevard - Spend some personal time on this notable street with easy access to various spots in the city, plenty of shopping opportunities and dining options.

Grindelwald First Experience

© Gondola Ride to Grindelwald First (Entrance Included) - Runs from the glacier village of Grindelwald towards First at 2,168m above sea level. Sit back and enjoy the breathtaking view of the mountain landscape.

First Cliff Walk presented by Tissot - This elevated walkway leads up to a platform with a vantage point that stretches 45m over the void below, and offers an unimpeded view of a typically Swiss mountain range.

Grindelwald Village - Leisure through this beautiful little town tucked in the centre of the Bernese Mountains offering a great escape from the metropolitan lifestyle, with its alpine splendour.

Return to Interlaken for dinner and overnight stay.







Lake Blausee (Entrance Included) - Unique lake with crystalline blue water and forests overlooking the snow-capped mountains.

Transfer to Montreux, a picturesque I akeside town, famous for jazz and landscapes

Montreux Christmas Market - Experience a festive wonderland with twinkling lights, charming stalls, and a flying Santa overhead, creating holiday magic for all. *Subject to opening dates.







Montreux - Tasch AZermatt -Gornegrat - Zermatt Tasch - Montreux

Depart to Tasch and ride on the shuttle train to Zermatt.

E Zermatt - An idyllic mountain village tucked away in the Swiss Alps, lies at the foot of Matterhorn. Walk along and photo stop at Bahnhofstrasse, Kirchplatz, Kirchbrucke bridge and English church before proceeding to lunch.

(i) Gornergrat Train Ride (Included) - From Zermatt, head up towards Gornergrat and experience a panoramic view of the magnificent Alps as you spot the most beautiful mountain in the world - the majestic Matterhorn.

Proceed to Montreux for dinner and overnight stay.
