Gobustan & Baku Guided Tour

Gobustan National Park - Discover the surreal **Gobustan Mud Volcano (Included)**, hearing gurgling mud. Explore the **Gobustan Rock Art Cultural Landscape [UNESCO] (Included)**, featuring ancient carvings and cave paintings. Experience the mesmerizing Gaval Dash, producing music when touched with a small stone.

Yanar Dag (Entrance Included) - Known as the "burning mountain", the natural gas fire has been continuously burning for a thousand years even in the rain.

Ateshgah (Entrance Included) - Visit the renowned ancient Zoroastrian Temple of Eternal Fire, authentic Azerbaijani exotic. Discover why fire-worshippers flocked the temple to worship the relic.

DAY 4 Tbilisi - Ananuri - Stepantsminda 152KM

🍴 Breakfast 🍽️ Lunch 🍷 Dinner

Ananuri Fortress - Located by the Aragvi River since the 13th century, you'll find the castle, bell tower and 3 churches with beautifully carved walls inside this fortress.

Transfer to 📍 **Stepantsminda**, commonly known as Kazbegi. Be captivated by its breathtaking landscape and the Mount Kazbek.

The Russia-Georgia Friendship Monument - Monument built in 1983 to celebrate the bicentennial of the Treaty of Georgievsk and the ongoing friendship between Soviet Georgia and Soviet Russia, overlooking the Devil's Valley.

Georgian Military Road - Known as one of the spectacular road, admire the scenery of aged snow-capped Caucasus Mountains as you travel through the emerald-green hills and valleys.

Gergeti Trinity Church - An architecture from the 14th century perched at 2,200m above the town backdropped by the picturesque mountains.

Transfer to **Borjomi**, known for its serene nature.

Borjomi Central Park - Enjoy leisurely strolls amid greenery at this scenic retreat featuring mineral water springs before dinner and overnight stay.

Mtskheta Guided Tour

Mtskheta, an ancient capital of the Eastern Georgian Kingdom from the 3rd century BC to the 5th century AD. It was also the location where Christianity was proclaimed as the kingdom's official religion.

Jvari Monastery [UNESCO] - Perched on top of the mountain, the extremely picturesque nature of this area. It is one of the most important Orthodox buildings in Georgia.

Svetitskhoveli Cathedral [UNESCO] - A masterpiece of the early middle ages. Built on the site of a wooden church, originally its interior was decorated with wall paintings, but these were whitewashed over.

Khinkali Master Class (Included) - Experience the art of making traditional Georgian dumplings, Khinkali that brings flavours and culture to life. Continue exploring **Tbilisi** at your leisure, immersing in vibrant culture, then enjoy **Georgian specialties dinner** with **folk dance performance** at night.

Yerevan, the stunning capital of Armenia and the country's largest city which is filled with Soviet-era architecture.

Yerevan Guided Tour

Temple of Garni (Entrance Included) - Surrounded by a vineyard and a beautiful mountain gorge, this unique architecture was built similarly to the iconic Temple of Athena in Greece and has survived since the pagan period.

Symphony of Stones (Entrance included) - One of the most well-known and beautiful natural monuments of Armenia which is said is the result of the collapse of the volcanic rocks.

Geghard Monastery [UNESCO] (Entrance included) - Explore the Armenian medieval architecture which within the walls are a complex of churches, chapels and gravels developed into the cliff that includes a magnificent entry hall, or gavit, and the Church of St. Gregory.

Ruins of Zvartnots [UNESCO] (Entrance included) - Visit the 7th century ruins with 1,300 years of history with the dormant volcano Mount Ararat as stunning backdrop.

Cascade Complex - Iconic Yerevan landmark featuring cascading steps and fountains, where it offers panoramic city views from its summit.

Republic Square - Located at the heart of the city, many come here during the night to admire the attractive dancing fountain performance.
