## ITINERARY

DAY 1 Kuala Lumpur → Berlin

Dinner

**Berlin**, the capital and chief urban centre of Germany. The city survived the destruction of World War II and show amazing economic and cultural growth ever since.

### Berlin Guided Tour

**Berlin Wall** - Soak in the historical riches with a tinge of nostalgia as you trace the walls of Berlin that once separated the East and West Germany.

**Checkpoint Charlie** - the name given by the Western Allies to the best-known Cold War frontier. Continue the tour to **Brandenburg Gate, Reichstag Building, Berlin Cathedral, Memorial to the Murdered Jews of Europe.**

To top it off, feast like a local at the Hofbrau Wirtshaus with a crispy pork knuckles, juicy sausages and German craft beer!

DAY 2 Berlin - Dresden - Prague

Breakfast Lunch

Depart to **Dresden**, the Jewel Box of Saxony, situated in a valley on the River Elbe, labeled for its incomparable ensemble of Baroque and Rococo architecture.

### Dresden Guided Tour

**Frauenkirche** - Built as a Catholic church until it became Protestant during the Reformation, being demolished in World War II and was then replaced in the 18th century by a larger Baroque Lutheran building.

**Zwinger Palace** - Stroll through the magnificent gardens and courtyards built in Baroque style.

**Furstenzug** - A large mural of a mounted procession of the rulers of Saxony.

Continue the tour to **Semper Opera, Neumarkt and Altmarkt Square.**

**Prague Castle** - Visit **St. Vitus Cathedral**, courtyards and squares in the largest coherent castle complex in the world.

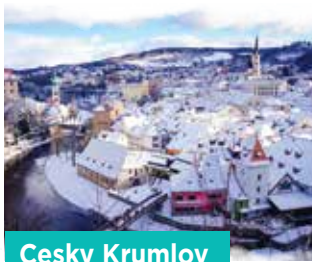
**Charles Bridge** - Admire the stunning view of the Prague castle from the historic pedestrian bridge.

### DAY 4 Prague - Cesky Krumlov - Salzburg 388KM

Return to the Middle Ages in **Cesky Krumlov [UNESCO]** as you cross the bridge over the Vltava River and step into this medieval town with well preserved structures a few centuries old.

#### **Cesky Krumlov Guided Tour**

**Old Town** - After delighting in a traditional Czech Kulajda soup as a starter for lunch, head off to roam the quaint and compact town, a very photogenic site.

**State Castle** - Appreciate the architecture and history of the most important attraction in Krumlov situated on a rock promontory, towering over the rest.

**Lazebnický Bridge** - One of the famous scenic spots in the old town, this wooden bridge connects Latrán with the Inner City and scores a 360 degree view of the quaint town. Spend your free time wandering about till departing to **Salzburg** for an overnight stay.

 **Lake Grundlsee** - Enjoy personal time taking a peaceful walk around the largest lake in Styria, admiring the breathtaking mountain scenery, and spending a tranquil night in this beautiful area.
