DAY 1 Kuala Lumpur → Sarajevo

Dinner

Sarajevo, the capital city of Bosnia and Herzegovina, is a beautiful city set against the backdrop of mountains, whose slopes formed a perfect setting for the Winter Olympics in 1984.

Sarajevo Guided Tour

Bascarsija Square - The historical and cultural centre with Sarajevo's oldest bazaar and the Sebilj Wooden Fountain.

Wall of Dubrovnik (Entrance Included) - Step foot at the iconic 1,940m long defensive stone wall encircling the city.

The Riva Promenade - Much like the cities' living room, walk through Split's 1,700 years of history in the stunning seafront promenade lined with tall palm trees, bustling cafés, and shaded benches.

Old City Hall - Erected in 1906, this Gothic-style building with a touch of Venetian design opened as Split's City Hall.

Statue of Gregory of Nin - Erected in 1929 to commemorate the bishop himself, local folklore has it that if you rub the big toe on the statue's left foot, good luck will follow.

Vestibulum of Diocletian's Palace - An ancient palace resembling a fortress built for the Roman emperor Diocletian which today forms about half the old town of Split, Croatia.

Model Grada Splita - A large city panorama made of bronze on the promenade. It shows in a catchy way Split's winding old town.

Preseren Square - Walk through the old town by the Ljubljana River and admire the **Triple Bridge** and the beautiful pink coloured **Town Hall**.

Predjama Castle (Entrance Included) - A stunning Renaissance castle situated in the middle of a 123m high cliff, inevitably surrounded by magnificent scenery has also been named largest cave castle by the Guinness World Record.

Postojna Cave (Entrance Included) - Ride a mini-train through the second longest cave system in a 2-million-year-old cave and witness a whole other kingdom underground of karst corridors, galleries and halls.
