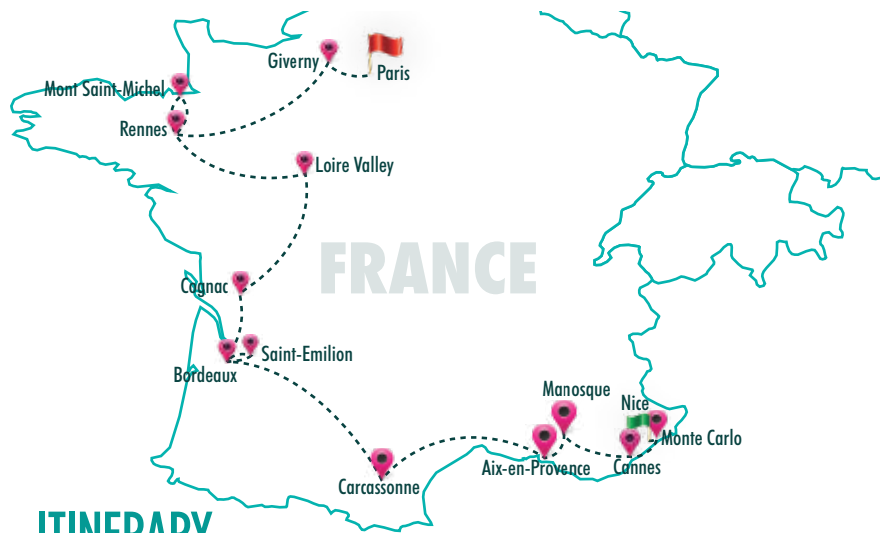

DAY 1 Kuala Lumpur → Nice

Dinner

**Nice [UNESCO]**, a seaport city which offers you everything needed for a great time - stunning beaches, sensational bars and restaurants, amazing views, and wonderful culture.

### Nice Guided Tour

**Place Massena** - Begin the tour from Nice's main square and walk towards **Rossetti Square** located in the centre of Old Nice.

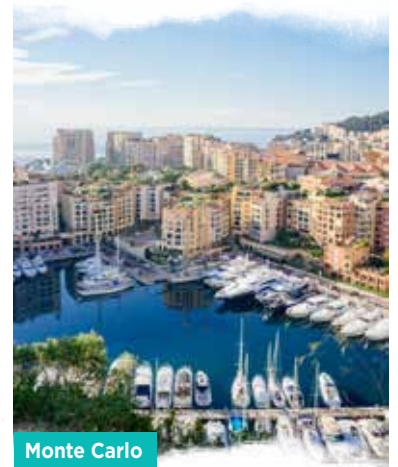
**Cathedrale Sainte-Reparate** - Visit the cultural and historical landmark named after Saint Reparata, a 15-year old Palestinian martyr.

**Bellanda Tower** - Built as a defensive tower back in 1825 with mosaics of Greek motifs, this tower overlooking the city is perfect for vistas and panoramic views.

Continue to **Cours Saleya**, **"#I Love Nice" Sign**, and **Promenade des Anglais**. Personal time to stroll around the Old Nice or taste the local Niçoise snack.

DAY 2 Nice - Eze - Monte Carlo

Breakfast Lunch Dinner

**Eze**, a medieval village located between Monaco and Nice, renowned for its impressive architecture, stunning views, and unique position overlooking the French Riviera.

**Parfumerie Galimard (Entrance Included)** - Discover the perfume capital of the world, visit a traditional French parfumerie, learn the secrets of fragrance-making, and later create your own signature scent!

Head to **Monte Carlo**, a luxurious tourist hotspot known for its tax-free status, and abundance of high-end hotels, resorts, and casinos.

**Monaco Cathedral** - Descent towards the state-city of Monaco on the "Rock", the final resting place of Princess Grace and Prince Rainier III.

**Prince's Palace** - The official residence of the Sovereign Prince of Monaco. You will be given some free time to wander around the old town for a souvenir or even admire the view from the St. Martin Gardens.

**Formula One Grand Prix** - Embrace the excitement at the famous race circuit in the second smallest country in the world.

Photostop at **Monte Carlo Casino Square** and **Rock of Monaco**.

### DAY 3 Monte Carlo - Cannes - Manosque - Aix-en-Provence 283KM


 Breakfast  Dinner

Depart to **Cannes**, renowned for the glamorous Cannes Film Festival and beloved by the wealthy for its year-round beach culture, gourmet cuisine, and luxurious hotels.

**Palace of Festivals and Congresses of Cannes** - Begin the tour by visiting the venue of the Cannes Film Festival and other international events, and then admire over 150 celebrity handprints on the star-studded floor of **Le Chemin des Etoiles**.

**Church of Our Lady of Good Voyage** - Hilltop Gothic-style stone church with bell tower completed in the 1600s, featuring a musical crèche and city views.

Depart to **Manosque**.


 **L'Occitane en Provence Guided Factory Tour (Included)** - Take a guided journey through the factory to learn about the manufacturing processes with sensorial experiences and awaken your senses as you wander through the Mediterranean garden. Finish with souvenir shopping at the renovated boutique before continuing overnight in **Aix-en-Provence**.

### DAY 4 Aix-en-Provence - Carcassonne 296KM

 Breakfast  Lunch  Dinner

 **Carcassonne**, one of the oldest cities in the country. **Historic Fortified City of Carcassonne [UNESCO] Guided Tour**  
**Chateau Comtal (Entrance Included)** - Discover the medieval castle towering on a hill that stands out for its beautiful architecture and regal history.

**Pont Marengo Bridge** - This gorgeous bridge provides access to the railway station of Carcassonne. From here, you may admire the surrounding beauty while watching canal boats go by.

**Basilica of Saints Nazarius and Celsus** - Completed in 1330, this national monument with Gothic-Romanesque architecture style earned the nickname of "Jewel of the City".

**Carcassonne Cathedral** - Originally built in the 13th Century, this cathedral has been rebuilt and restored to preserve its original architectural features. Today, it is known for its stunning Gothic architecture, remarkable interiors and historical significance.

**Palais de la Bourse** - Step onto the world's largest reflecting pool, **Water Mirror**, and be amazed by this historical palace, a home to the Chamber of Commerce and Industry of Bordeaux.

**Saint-Andre Cathedral** - Immerse in the grand gothic architecture, intricate details, and rich history for captivating experience.

 **Cité du Vin Decanter (Entrance Included)** - Discover Bordeaux's world-famous wine culture through immersive exhibits and interactive experiences, with an opportunity to enjoy panoramic views from the observation deck.

Continue to discover sites such as **Porte Cailhau**, **Monument aux Girondins**, **Esplanade de Quinconces** and **Grand Theatre de Bordeaux**.

**Rue Sainte Catherine** - Enjoy personal time to shop along Europe's longest pedestrian street.


**Les Halles Bacalan** - Enjoy a leisurely exploration of this bustling market, where farmers, artisans, and regional chefs come together to showcase their goods and share a genuine culinary experience.
