Plaza de Espana - One of the largest squares in the country featuring a large fountain and a monument to Cervantes.

Segovia Guided Tour

Roman Aqueduct of Segovia - Two-tiered arches standing tall at 28m high and 894m wide, you'll find yourself gaping at the originality of this man-made wonder!

Alcazar of Segovia - Perched atop a cliff, the Alcazar in sight is a castle so fairytale-like, you can't help but wonder if it's real.

Continue the tour to Plaza Mayor and Plaza San Martin.

Famous Roast Suckling Pig - For a unique culinary experience, you'll be surprised as chefs prove the pork's tenderness by cutting it with a blunt plate!

Transfer to Madrid and enjoy leisure time along Gran Via, before settling in for the night.









Madrid - Toledo - Cordoba

Toledo [UNESCO] is a city standing on a high hill above the Tagus River with a rich collection of historical monuments.

Toledo Guided Tour

San Martin Bridge - Standing at this iconic bridge which overlooks the Tagus River, a charming overview of Toledo uniquely exhibits traces of Christian, Jew and Muslim influences.

Monastery of San Juan de los Reyes - A late Gothic style monastery built to commemorate the victory at the Battle of Toro.

Toledo Cathedral - One of the top attractions in Toledo well-known for its magnificent medieval Gothic architecture and the famous artwork inside.

Proceed overnight stay in Cordoba.



Cordoba - Seville

Cordoba, with the largest old town in Spain and the most UNESCO sites worldwide, is a must-visit for architecture enthusiasts.

Historic Centre of Cordoba [UNESCO] Guided Tour

The Alcazar de los Reyes Cristianos - This medieval palace in western Cordoba was once a primary residence of Catholic Monarchs Ferdinand and Isabella, and its terraced gardens are delightful to stroll around.

(E) Mezquita Cathedral [UNESCO] (Entrance Included) - One of the world's greatest works of Islamic architecture, reflects an age when diverse cultures interacted and enriched the city.

Continue the tour to Roman Bridge of Cordoba and Calleja de las Flores before having some leisure time in Plaza de la Corredera.

Transfer to Seville.

Lisbon, positioned on hills alongside the Tagus River, is a scenic city with colourful, picturesque streets that offer unexpected views at every turn.

Pena National Palace [UNESCO] (Entrance Included) - Take in the multi-coloured and vibrant Pena Palace situated in the Cultural Landscape of Sintra, a strong portrayal of the Romantic period before returning to Lisbon.

Lisbon Guided Tour

Jeronimos Monastery and Belem Tower [UNESCO] - Situated at the entrance of Lisbon harbour, showcases the best of Portuguese art, while the nearby **Tower of Belem** serves as a reminder of the great maritime discoveries that shaped the modern world.

Santa Justa Lift - This century-old iron tower is an elevator that links downtown to the Chiado district. It has a stunning observation deck at its 45m-high top, offering magnificent views of Lisbon's centre, and is one of the city's most photographed landmarks.

Famous Portuguese Egg Tart - Indulge in the "World's Best" Portuguese tart from Pasteis de Belem, a Lisbon must-try, then take personal time to explore Rossio Square and Rua Augusta.



Porto Guided Tour

Porto Cathedral - One of the city's oldest and most important local Romanesque monuments found at the historical centre of Porto. **Dom Luis I Bridge -** Get a glimpse of the double-decker bridge - an icon of the city of Porto - a marvel of 19th-century engineering. Avenue of the Allies - Visit Porto's busiest boulevard, perfect for shopping and socialising, with the Town Hall at the avenue's top. Montserrat Basilica (Entrance Included) - Located in the Montserrat Mountains, the basilica is renowned for the Black Madonna, Gothic architecture, stunning

Casa Mila and Casa Batllo [UNESCO] - Drive through the renowned buildings of Gaudí's masterpieces located in Barcelona's most elegant avenue, Passeig de Gracia. Photo stop at Magic Fountain of Montjuic.
