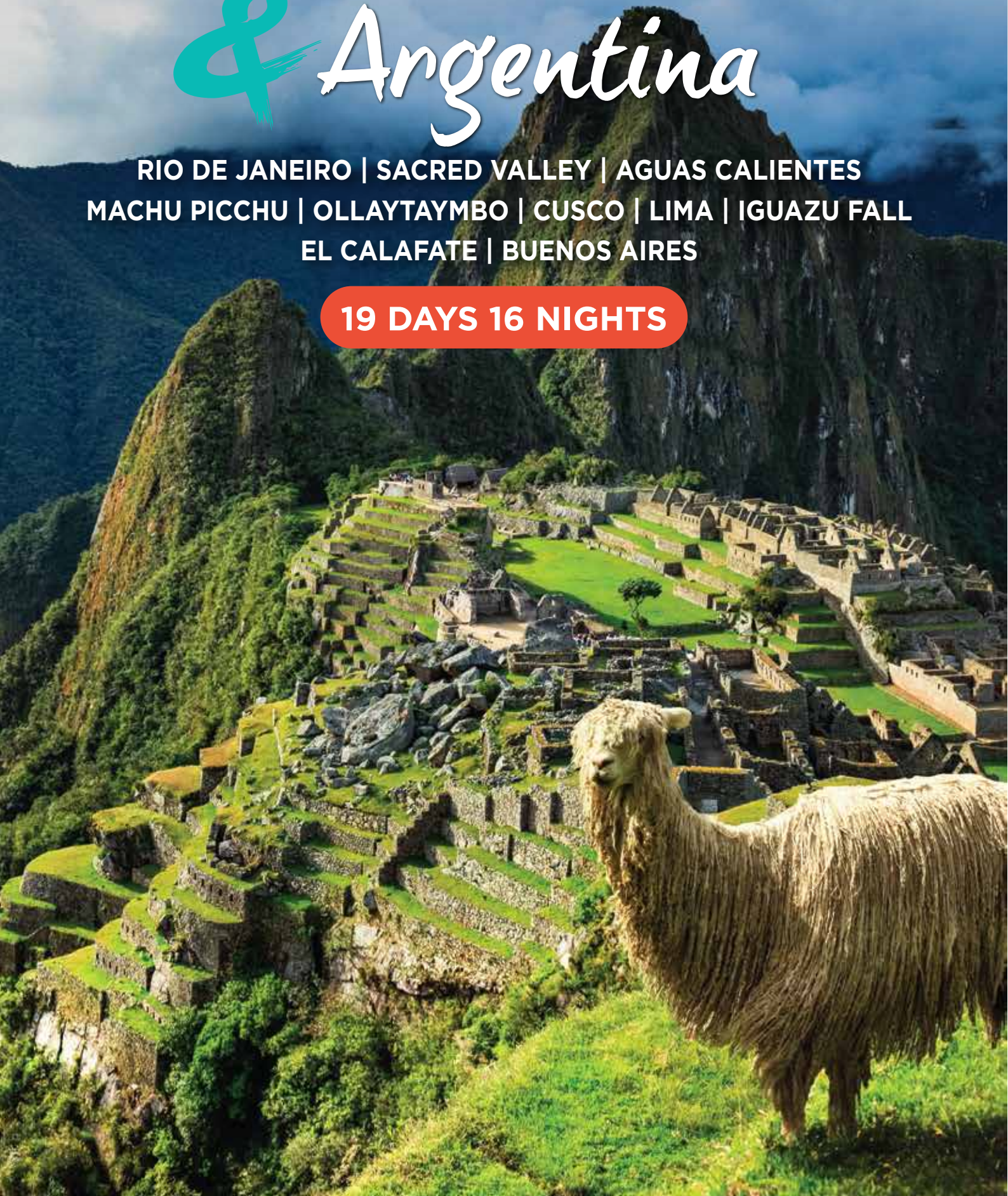

DAY 3 Rio De Janeiro

Corcovado Mountain (Entrance Included) - Part of the UNESCO-listed Carioca Landscapes between the Mountain and the Sea, enjoy an **Electric Tram Ride (Included)** through Tijuca National Park to the peak and admire **Christ the Redeemer**, along with breathtaking panoramic views of Rio's stunning cityscape. **Tram subject to weather conditions.*

Sugar Loaf Mountain - Take a scenic **Cable Car (Included)** up this iconic granite peak for stunning 360° views of Rio's beaches, mountains, **Guanabara Bay**, and the striking **Dedo de Deus** peak. **Cable car subject to weather conditions.*

DAY 4 Rio De Janeiro ✈️ Lima ✈️ Cusco

🍴 Breakfast 🍷 Dinner

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your flight from Rio de Janeiro to **Lima** in Peru, connecting onwards to **Cusco**. Upon arrival, check in at the hotel and settle in for the evening. End the day with a course dinner and enjoy a well-deserved night of comfort.

Sacred Valley Guided Tour

Pisac Andean Market - Explore a lively traditional market filled with colourful agricultural produce, handmade textiles, and unique Andean handicrafts, an ideal spot for cultural immersion and shopping.

Awanacancha (Entrance Included) - Visit this living museum to learn about Andean camelids such as llamas, alpacas, vicuñas, and guanacos, and watch an authentic demonstration of traditional weaving and natural dyeing techniques.

DAY 6 Sacred Valley - Ollantaytambo Machu Picchu - Aguas Calientes 34KM

- Breakfast Lunch Dinner

Chinchero - Visit this traditional Andean village famed for Church of Our Lady of the Nativity of Chinchero, built atop Inca foundations, showcasing a unique blend of Inca and Spanish heritage.

Moray - Explore the impressive circular agricultural terraces, an embedded amphitheatre used by the Incas as an important research centre to experiment with crops and microclimates.

Maras - Discover the remarkable Salt Ponds of Maras (Entrance Included), a dazzling patchwork of salt pools that have been harvested since Inca times before lunch. *Access subject to road and weather conditions.

Ollantaytambo Ruins (Entrance Included) - Discover the ancient Inca fortress and ceremonial site of Hanan Huacaypata, renowned for its massive terraces and sacred architecture. Also famed as the gateway to Machu Picchu.

Board the train from Ollantaytambo to Machu Picchu Station, followed by a short walk to Aguas Calientes for hotel check-in, dinner, and a restful overnight stay.

DAY 7 Aguas Calientes - Machu Picchu Poroy - Cusco 22KM

- Breakfast Lunch Dinner

Machu Picchu [UNESCO] - A New Wonder of the World and the crown jewel of Inca heritage, this once-in-a-lifetime tour reveals mysterious stonework and breathtaking mountain scenery. Start the tour at the entrance and ascend the zigzagging trail to the terraces for the iconic postcard view of the ancient citadel. *Access to certain viewpoints may be affected by weather or trail conditions.

After lunch, take the Vistadome Train (Included) from Machu Picchu Station to Poroy Station and continue to Cusco for dinner and an overnight stay.

DAY 8 Cusco

Breakfast Dinner

Cusco, the historic capital of the Inca Empire, blends ancient heritage with vibrant Andean culture.

Old City of Cusco [UNESCO] Guided Tour

Cusco Cathedral - Visit this grand colonial cathedral on Plaza de Armas, built atop an Inca palace with stunning religious art.

Koricancha - Visit the Incas' Sun Temple, topped by the **Convent of Santo Domingo**, revealing a striking blend of Inca stonework and Spanish colonial design.

After lunch, continue the tour to Cusco's surrounding sites, including **Tambomachay**, **Puca Pucara**, **Genko Amphitheater**, and **Sacsayhuaman Fortress**.

Vinicunca Rainbow Mountain Excursion - This full-day excursion begins early and follows a scenic mountain trail, ideal for adventurous travellers comfortable with high-altitude walking, and rewards you with stunning views of Vinicunca's rainbow-coloured slopes.

**Subject to weather and trail conditions.

Travellers can either go with the guided tour or the mountain excursion. The two activities run at the same time and cannot be combined.

After a guided tour or mountain excursion, return to **Cusco** for dinner and overnight stay.

DAY 9 Cusco → Lima

Travel to **Lima**, capital of Peru by flight.

Lima Guided Tour

Lima Cathedral (Entrance Included) - A grand colonial landmark on the Main Square of Lima's UNESCO historic centre, overlooking a 17th-century bronze fountain.

San Francisco Church (Entrance Included) - An iconic landmark in Lima's UNESCO-listed historic centre, famed for its Spanish Baroque architecture, catacombs, and striking colonial artworks.

Larco Museum (Entrance Included) - Discover pre-Columbian treasures inside an elegant 18th-century mansion with beautiful gardens.

Lastly, check in to the hotel for dinner and an overnight stay.

DAY 10 Lima → Buenos Aires → Puerto Iguazú

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your flight from Lima to **Buenos Aires** in Argentina, connecting onwards to **Puerto Iguazú**.

Iguazú Falls [UNESCO], one of the New Seven Wonders of Nature, is the world's largest waterfall system with 275 cascades and unforgettable rainforest scenery.

Iguazú Falls - Brazil Side (Entrance Included) - Enter **Foz do Iguacu National Park** and walk the scenic trail for sweeping views of **San Martín Island** and waterfalls including **Bozetti, Two Sisters, San Martín** and the **Three Musketeers**. Photostop at **Tres Fronteras**.

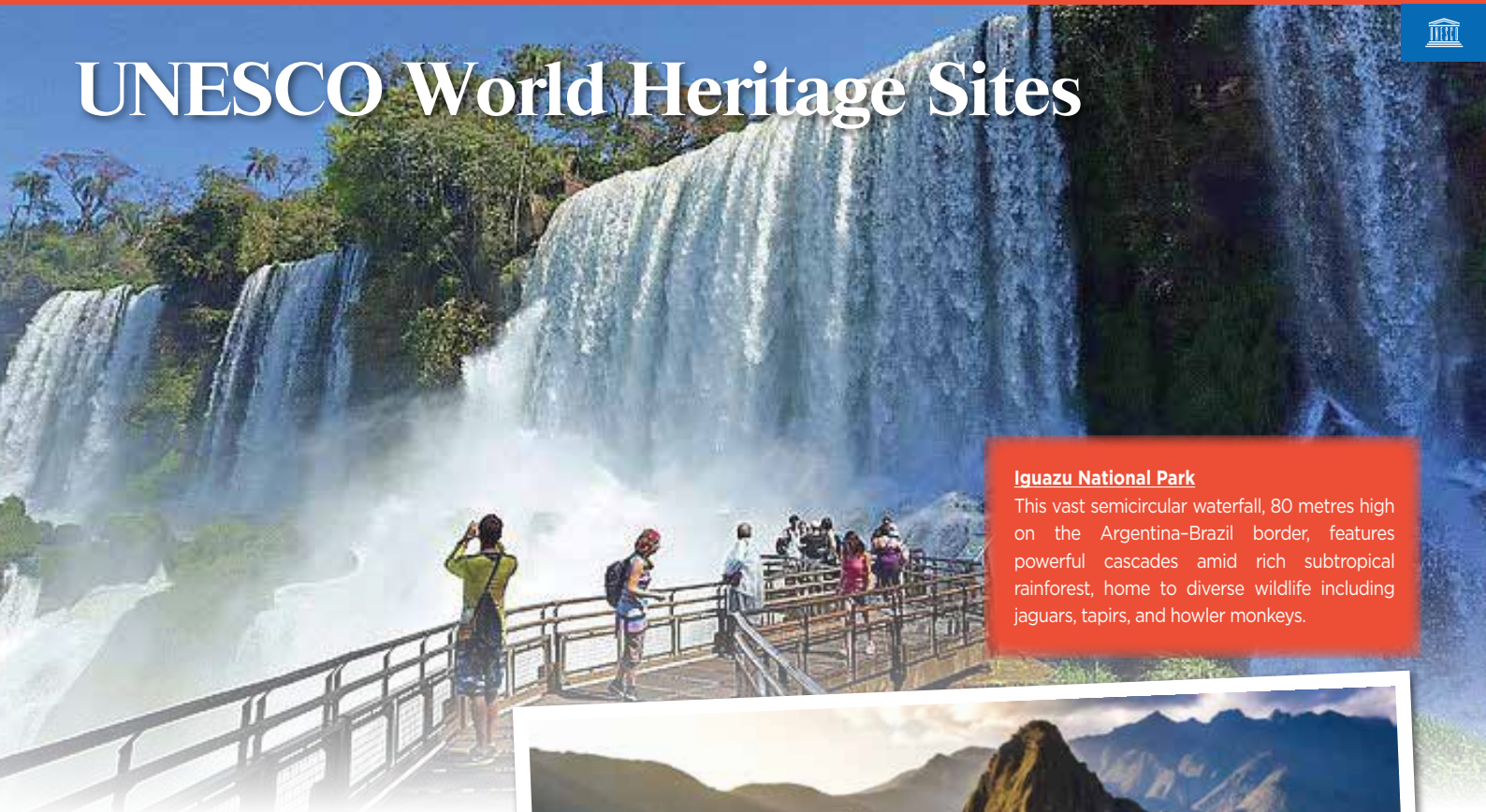

UNESCO World Heritage Sites

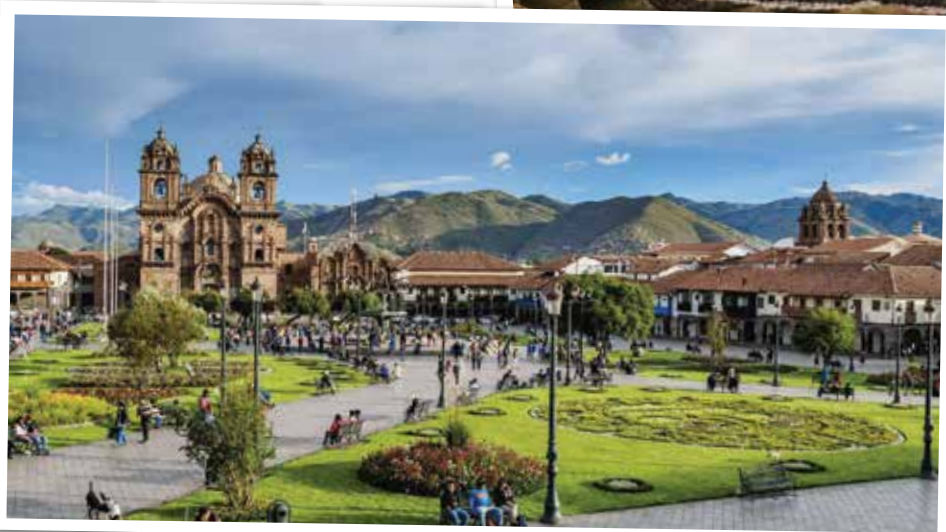


Iguazu National Park

This vast semicircular waterfall, 80 metres high on the Argentina-Brazil border, features powerful cascades amid rich subtropical rainforest, home to diverse wildlife including jaguars, tapirs, and howler monkeys.

Machu Picchu

Machu Picchu rises 2,430 metres above sea level, showcasing remarkable Inca engineering amid lush tropical forest, where dramatic stone terraces blend seamlessly with the Andes' natural landscape.



City of Cusco

Located in the Peruvian Andes, Cuzco evolved under Inca ruler Pachacutec into a religious and administrative centre, later layered with Spanish Baroque architecture over Inca foundations.
