

Old Town of Zurich - Located at the heart of Zurich, get lost in the winding road of this historic centre, finding shops, cafes and soak up the long passed atmosphere.

Discover the sights of Grossmunster Church, Wasserkirche, Zurich Town Hall, Paradeplatz.

Bahnhofstrasse - The world-renowned shopping avenues. Enjoy leisure time for a traditional coffee or exploring the shopping delights.

(g) Glacier Express / Bernina Express Scenic Train* (2nd Class Ticket Included) -Unforgettable railway experiences through the mountain landscape of Graubünden from Chur to Pontresina by crossing Landwasser Viaduct, one of the most iconic parts of the train journey, curving around into the Landwasser tunnel and Swiss Engadin Alps. *Subject to availability.

Chapel Bridge - This Lucerne's landmark is Europe's oldest covered bridge, dating back to the 14th century and originally serving as part of the city fortifications.

Stop for photos at Rathaus, and the St. Peter's Chapel. Then, enjoy leisure time at **Schwanenplatz**, renowned for Swiss watch shops, bars, and souvenir stalls.

Head to Interlaken.

Interlaken - Afternoon leisure in this scenic lakeside town, free to embrace diverse experiences such as shopping at Hoheweg Boulevard or thrilling activities. At night, relish a traditional Swiss dinner for a memorable evening in Interlaken.

Lauterbrunnen - With its 72 thundering waterfalls, secluded valleys, colourful alpine meadows and lonely mountain inns. Enjoy the magnificent spectacle view of Staubbach waterfall and stroll along the Lauterbrunnen Village.

(E) Swiss Gourmet Food and Wine Pairing - Offers a delightful journey through the country's culinary traditions, allowing you to indulge in a symphony of flavours and create a lasting experience.

Transfer to Broc.

Maison Cailler (Entrance Included) - The combined factory and museum tour gives you a glimpse of how Cailler's chocolate is made. The history of chocolate, the growing of cocoa beans and Cailler's approach are explained.

Continue to **Gruyeres** for leisure and dinner before the night ends.







Gruyeres - Tasch ដ Zermatt -**Gornergrat - Zermatt**

Depart to Tasch and ride on the Shuttle Train to Zermatt (Included).

Example 2 Zermatt, an idyllic mountain village tucked away in the Swiss Alps, lies at the foot of Matterhorn. Experience the charming Swiss atmosphere as you explore this car-free fairytale village from once a farming village.

Walk along and photo stop at Kirchplatz, Kirchbrucke Bridge and Matterhorn View Point, followed by free time for exploration.

Cogwheel Train Ride (Included) - Take the cogwheel train that goes from Zermatt to Gornergrat and back to Zermatt.

Gornergrat - From this vantage point, it immediately opens up the beautiful view of the Matterhorn and Gorner Glacier right in front of you after you leave the train.

Back to Tasch with Shuttle Train (Included), then depart to Geneva. **Geneva Guided Tour**

Palace of Nations and Broken Chair Monument - Home to the United Nation. Jet d'Eau (Water Jet) - The symbol and most famous landmark of Geneva. Visit the harbour and admire the mighty jet of water soars straight up from the lake surface.

Place du Bourg-de-Four - Possibly the oldest square in the city and certainly its most charming and atmospheric. Enjoy a stroll in this historical square where you'll find many cafes and restaurants.

Geneva Flower Clock and English Garden - One of the most famous Geneva attractions, it is the symbol of Geneva's clock-making industry.

Makes the eyes sparkle at the Rue du Rhône. The luxury shoppers' paradise where the most prestigious brands vie with one another in elegance and style.

At night, treat yourself to the indulgent experience of Swiss cheese fondue, savouring the rich flavours and Alpine charm.
