DAY 1 Kuala Lumpur ➔ Geneva

Geneva Flower Clock and English Garden - One of the most famous Geneva attractions, it is the symbol of Geneva's clock-making industry.

 **Lauterbrunnen** - This scenic village is famed for the magnificent **Staubach waterfall**, secluded valleys, colourful alpine meadows and lonely mountain inns.

Head to **Jungfrau**.

Gondola Ride & Scenic Train (Included) - Experience a gondola ride and scenic train to Europe's highest railway station, offering breathtaking Swiss Alps views and panoramic landscapes. ***Subject to operation hour.**

Personal Time To Discover - Explore the Jungfrau summit at your own pace! Hoheweg Boulevard - Spend some personal time on this notable street with easy access to various spots in the city, plenty of shopping opportunities and dining options.

Transfer to **Lucerne**, the gateway to central Switzerland, surrounded by a breathtaking mountainous panorama.

Lion Monument - One of the most famous monuments in Switzerland to honour the sacrifice of the Swiss Guards defending the King of France sparking huge controversy.

Chapel Bridge - This Lucerne's landmark is Europe's oldest covered bridge, dating back to the 14th century and originally serving as part of the city fortifications.

Stop for photos at **Rathaus**, and the **St. Peter's Chapel**. Then, enjoy leisure time at **Schwanenplatz**, renowned for Swiss watch shops, bars, and souvenir stalls.

Proceed overnight in **Chur**.

Glacier Express / Bernina Express Scenic Train* (2nd Class Ticket Included) - Unforgettable railway experiences through the mountain landscape of Graubünden from Chur to Pontresina by crossing **Landwasser Viaduct**, one of the most iconic parts of the train journey, curving around into the Landwasser tunnel and Swiss Engadin Alps. **Subject to availability.*

St. Moritz, a high Alpine resort town in the Engadine in Switzerland and has twice hosted the Winter Olympics.

Lake St. Moritz - A lake at St. Moritz, Switzerland. With a surface of 0.78 km² and a picturesque view surrounded by the Swiss Alps.

Town Center - Indulge in personal time exploring the charming town.

Proceed overnight in **Chur**.

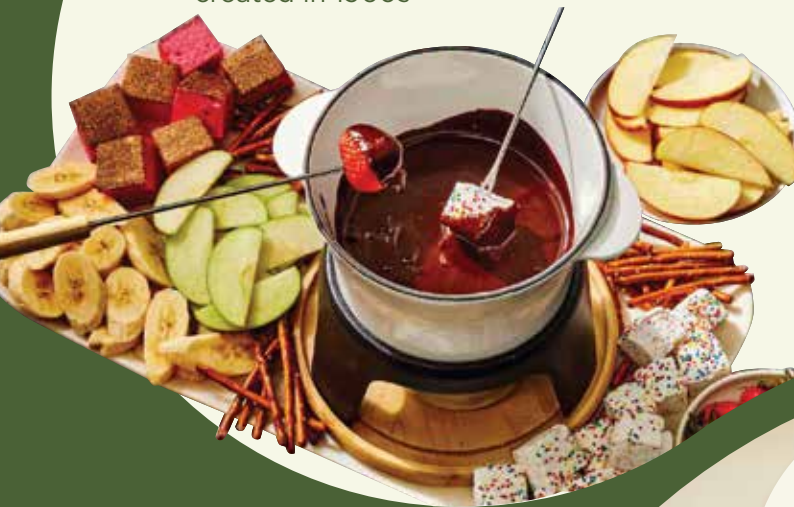
