Kuala Lumpur 🐆 Zurich - Chur

Zurich, the world's largest financial hub with a mix of well-preserved Old Town and modern life plus a view of the snowy Swiss Alps.

Old Town of Zurich - Located at the heart of Zurich, get lost in the winding road of this historic centre, finding shops and cafes while you soak up the long passed atmosphere. Walk past and photo stop at Grossmunster Church, Wasserkirche, Zurich Town Hall, Paradeplatz. Bahnhofstrasse - The world-renowned shopping avenues. Have some personal free time shopping or enjoy a cup of traditional coffee .

Proceed overnight in Chur.

Chur, the oldest town in Switzerland with a settlement history of over 5,000 years. St. Martin's Church - A historic place of worship known for its architectural beauty and religious significance.

Cathedral of Saint Mary of the Assumption - A majestic religious landmark featuring stunning Gothic architecture and rich historical significance.

Sankt Martinsplatz - Vibrant square with cafes, shops, and lively atmosphere, often featuring historical landmarks and architectural beauty.

Altstadt - Historic Old Town area characterized by narrow streets, charming architecture, shops, and a rich cultural heritage.

Enjoy your personal time and a hearty lunch before transfer to St. Moritz.

(Glacier Express / Bernina Express Scenic Train* (Included) - Unforgettable railway experiences through the mountain landscape of Graubünden from Chur to Pontresina by crossing Landwasser Viaduct, one of the most iconic parts of the Glacier Express, curving around into the Landwasser tunnel and Swiss Engadin Alps.

St. Moritz - A high Alpine resort town in the Engadine in Switzerland and has twice hosted the Winter Olympics.

Lake St. Moritz - A lake at St. Moritz. Switzerland. With a surface of 0.78 km² and a picturesque view surrounded by the Swiss Alps.

Enjoy shopping at Via Serlas, La Serletta and Via Veglia.
