Board the Afrosiyob High-Speed Train (Included) to Bukhara, the storied city of Aladdin, where time seems to stand still.

Bukhara Old City [UNESCO] Guided Tour

The Ark Citadel (Entrance Included) - Admire the massive fortress that once housed emirs and royals, with the elegant Bolo-Khauz Mosque just opposite.

Kalon Complex (Entrance Included) - Marvel at the enduring Po-i-Kalyan Minaret, untouched by Genghis Khan, and explore the adjoining Kalon Mosque, one of the largest in Central Asia.

Lyabi-Khauz Complex - Stroll the 17th-century poolside square where history meets daily life. Continue with an authentic tea experience at the Silk Road Tea House before strolling the Trade Domes, Bukhara's historic Silk Road bazaars.

End the day with a rooftop dinner of local specialties, overlooking Bukhara's enchanting old-town skyline.

Cotton Picking - Join the seasonal harvest in Uzbekistan's cotton fields. Available only in September and October.

Journey to Samarkand - Drive via Navoi to Sarmishsay Gorge, where thousands of ancient petroglyphs cover the rocks. Stop at the Sardoba Water Reservoir, a Silk Road landmark, before continuing to Nurota to visit the sacred Chashma Complex, with its spring, mosque, and fortress ruins linked to Alexander the Great. Along the way, admire seasonal scenery with blooming orchards in April and golden harvest landscapes in October.

Wrap up the day's journey with dinner and overnight in Samarkand.



Cross into Tajikistan and journey to Panjakent, known as the Pompeii of Central Asia. Sarazm Archaeological Site [UNESCO] (Entrance Included) - Explore the

Seven Lakes - Let nature surprise you at every turn as you explore a surreal chain of turquoise lakes tucked in the Fann Mountains. Formed by natural rock charm, like a series of hidden gems waiting to be uncovered. *Reaching the Seven Lakes requires mountain roads, which may be affected by weather and road conditions.

Proceed overnight by Iskanderkul Lake.











Transfer to Istaravshan, a timeless city where mud-brick houses, ancient mosques, and bustling bazaars capture the spirit of Central Asia. Its well-preserved architecture and unhurried pace offer a rare glimpse into authentic heritage.

Mug Tepa Archaeological Site (Entrance Included) - Explore the ancient ruins that offer a glimpse into Istaravshan's centuries-old past. Sheikh Muslihiddin Mausoleum (Entrance Included) - Visit this elegant mausoleum, an important spiritual site dedicated to the revered poet and ruler Sheikh Muslihiddin.

Istaravshan Bazaar - Wander through the lively market where locals trade fresh produce, fragrant spices, and traditional crafts.

Dine in a Local House - Be welcomed into a traditional house where rich flavours and heartfelt hospitality turn a simple meal into a lasting memory.

Proceed to Khujand for dinner and overnight stay.
