D1 Kuala Lumpur → Reykjavik

Reykjavik City Tour

Visit town's charm which lies in the small, candy-coloured houses, the public artwork and the people on the streets.

Reykjavik Church (Hallgrímskirkja) - Visit the stunning Icelandic nature inspired architecture church. Standing tall at 73metres making it the tallest structures in Iceland.

Austurvöllur Square - One of the most popular places in the city, on a sunny day many local gather on this square to relax. The Parliament building, Reykjavik's cathedral Domkirkjan are a huge important landmark to the city's cultural history line.

Harpa Concert Hall - Visit huge gleaming structure on the waters edge that at first glance looks like a distorted rubiks cubes. Outfitted with tens of thousands of LED lights, this building literally comes alive with color in the evening,

Sun Voyager - The Sun Voyager is a sculpture located next to the Sæbraut road in Reykjavik. It described as a dreamboat, or an ode to the Sun. The artist intended it to convey the promise of undiscovered territory, a dream of hope, progress and freedom.

Laugavegur - the main shopping street in Reykjavik, renowned for Iceland's coolest shops, boutiques, restaurants and bars. Also is one of the oldest streets in Iceland's capital. Its name roughly translates to 'the Water Road', as it was up and down this area where women used to bring their laundry to be washed in the hot pools.

Overnight at **Reykjavik**.

D3 Reykjavik - Golden Circle - Vik

Golden Circle

Thingvellir National Park [UNESCO] - Played a dominant role in Icelandic history as a symbol of Independence. Take a stroll at the national park and admire the outstanding nature. Witness the continental drift up close.

Strokkur Geysir Geothermal - One of the top attractions in Iceland where you'll captivate by its powerful, shooting eruptions of boiling water, up to 40m in the air.

Gullfoss Waterfall - You will certainly remember this waterfall because its unique formation, where you view the falls from above and it appears that the Iceland waterfall is actually going underground its truly an incredible sight!

Proceed to overnight at **Vik**.

D4 Vik - Vatnajökull National Park - Vik

(B, L, D) 380KM

Vatnajökull National Park [UNESCO]

One of three national parks in Iceland, it encompasses all of Vatnajökull glacier and extensive surrounding areas. These include the national parks previously existing at Skaftafell in the southwest and Jökulsárgljúfur in the north.

Jökulsárlón Glacier Lagoon & Diamond Beach - You will be left speechless as you make a stop at the ice lagoon. Filled with a huge iceberg and each has its shimmering and unique natural ice sculpture reflecting rainbow glints they are a mind-blowing sight as they sail towards the Atlantic Sea.



E **Mýrdalsjökull Glacier & Crystal Ice Cave Tour (Entrance & Super Jeep Included)** - Enter the ice cave for a truly magical 'gateway' as blue & black ice walls stand like sentinels on either side of you. Inside this ice-dome, you will feel you are in a magical Hollywood scene. Overnight at **Vik**.

D5 Vik - South Coast- Reykjavik (B, L, D) 248KM

South Coast

Reynisfjara Black Sand Beach - Created by lava flowing into the ocean which cools almost immediately when touching the water, formed the black sand beach that's there today.

Reynisfjall - With its incredibly tall basalt columns, towering cliffs and caves, it makes for quite a sight.

Skógafoss Waterfall - One of the largest waterfalls in the country. It is famous for its consistent produces a single and double rainbow. Climb up the 370 steps and you'll be rewarded with a panoramic view of the coastline.

Seljalandsfoss Waterfall - It's truly an amazing sight as you watch the water gracefully topple over the edge of the 60m cliffs and plummets into the Seljalands river.

Proceed to overnight at **Reykjavik**.

D6 Reykjavik - Snaefellsnes - Borgarnes (B, L, D) 310KM

Snaefellsnes Peninsula

The Snaefellsnes peninsula is referred to as "Iceland in Miniature". Everything from mountains, caves, gorges, craters, waterfalls, beaches, and ocean views condensed into one smaller region that can be seen in a day.

E **Mount Kirkjufell** - One of the most photographed mountains in Iceland. It is recognized as 'Arrow Head Mountain' in the Game of Thrones. With the mountain looming in the background and a winding river with Kirkjufellsfoss waterfalls in front, it's a beautiful scenic spot for viewing and photographs.

Arnarstapi - Admire the basalt columns, sea arches and caves which were forged by lava from the Snaefellsjökull volcano.

Djúpalónssandur - One of the most beautiful black lava pearl beaches in Iceland. Located in the middle of Snaefellsjökull National Park; a national park full of lava fields mostly covered by moss, created around the famous Snaefellsjökull glacier.

Lónranganar - Uniquely formed basalt volcanic dykes sticking out from the ocean and are the remains of a crater that looks like a huge castle reaching out to the sea.

Icelandic Horse Farm Tour (Entrance Included) - Get up close and meet the unique breed Icelandic horses. They are well known for their friendly temperament and vibrant personality. Experience attending the Icelandic horses in their home with daily grooming on these incredible animals.

Overnight at **Borgarnes**.

*Proceed with aurora hunting bus excursion (whenever weather permits).

E **Akureyri Church** - Gaze up at the modern-looking structure and marvel the stained-glass panel and the 3,300 huge pipe organ that are among the treasures of this modern church that towers over the city.

Akureyri Botanical Garden - Explore one of the northernmost botanical gardens in the world. Discover more 400 flower species growing in the garden beds and nursery.

Enjoy personal time to explore Downtown Akureyri.

Overnight at **Akureyri**.

D8 Akureyri - Myvatn - Dettifoss - Akureyri

(B, L, D) 308KM

Myvatn Sightseeing

E **Goðafoss** - Visit the 30-meter wide horseshoe-shaped that separates the waterfall in two. Admire incredible natural phenomena from the top and bottom.

E **Lake Myvatn** - Created in a basaltic lava eruption 2300 years ago. Due to its volcanic land, the lake is surrounded by various landscapes and amazing geological formations.

Dimmuborgir Lava Formations - Discover the unique formation from the apocalyptic lava flow around 2000 years ago. Admire the composed of various volcanic caves and strange rock formations, reminiscent of an ancient collapsed city.

Námafjall & Námaskarð Hot Springs - Surrounded by hot springs and mud pots, the Marvel the colourful sulfur crystal and gigantic mud craters is truly awe-inspiring sight.

E **Dettifoss (subject to weather and road condition)** - Known for being the most powerful waterfall in Europe. Feel the sheer size and power as you stand next to the waterfall is probably one of the most humbling experiences that you'll ever experience.

Overnight at **Akureyri**.

*Proceed with aurora hunting bus excursion (whenever weather permits).



D9 Akureyri → Reykjavik - Grindavik - Reykjavik

(B, L, X) 70KM

Depart to Reykjavik by domestic flight. Upon arrival, proceed to Grindavik.

Blue Lagoon (Comfort Pack Entrance Included) - Soak in at the most famous attraction in the hot thermal bath where it has active ingredients such as silica, minerals and algae which will keep your skin healthy and youthful.
